The Indian military peacekeeper serving with the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO) who has been awarded the prestigious 2023 United Nations Military Gender Advocate of the Year Award – **Major Radhika Sen**

The Bengaluru based medical institution which has been awarded the Nelson Mandela Award for Health Promotion for 2024 by the World Health Organization – **NIMHANS**

The book written by German writer Jenny Erpenbeck, translated by Michael Hofmann, which has been named the winner of the International Booker Prize 2024 – **Kairos**

The film written and directed by Payal Kapadia, which has become the first film from India to win the Grand Prix at 77th Cannes Film Festival in France – **All we imagine as light**

The Indian bowler who has become the first Indian cricketer to take 350 wickets in T20 matches (International and IPL matches included) – **Yuzvendra Chahal**

The team which has won both the 2024 Thomas Cup and Uber Cup badminton championships defeating Indonesia in both the finals in Chengdu, China – **China**

The Captain of the Indian squad announced for the 2024 ICC Men's T20 World Cup to be held in June 2024 – **Rohit Sharma**

The West Indies cricketer who has been banned by ICC for five years for violating anticorruption codes – **Devon Thomas**

BHISHMA Portable Hospital

- 1. The hospital was tested by the Indian Air Force at Agra by air-dropping it and making it operational within 12 minutes.
- 2. The portable hospital has been developed as part of Project BHISHMA (Bharat Health Initiative for Sahyog Hita and Maitri).
- 3. It consists of a fully equipped operation theatre, mini-ICUs, ventilators, blood-testing equipment, an X-ray machine, and even a cooking station.
- 4. A shelter facility and power generator make it entirely self-sufficient during emergencies.
- 5. The life-saving equipment are packed in a set of mini-cubes and a combination of these mini-cubes is used to set up a mobile hospital capable of performing life-saving surgery.

First Pig Kidney Transplant

- The first man to receive a genetically modified pig kidney transplant died on 11 May 2024, two months after the operation.
- Richard Slayman, 62, underwent the surgery in March 2024.
- The operation was carried out at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH), Boston (USA).
 The kidney from the pig had undergone 69 genome edits to make it suitable for use in humans.
