The former Chief Minister of Gujarat who passed away on 29.10.2020 – **Shri Keshubhai Patel**

The first Indian to win Academy Award (for her costume design in film Gandhi (1982)) and National Award for Costume Design for films Lekin and Lagaan, who passed away on 15.10.2020 – **Bhanu Athaiya**

The renowned Malayalam poet, recipient of Jnanpith Award (2019), Padma Shri (2017) and Sahitya Akademi Award (1971), who passed away on 15.10.2020 – **Akkitham Achuthan Namboothiri**

The renowned Kuchipudi dancer, recipient of Padma Shri (2001) and Sangeet Natak Akademi Award (1991), who passed away on 14.10.2020 – **Sobha Naidu**

The Union Minister who has been given the additional charge of Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Administration following the death of Shri Ram Vilas Paswan – **Shri Piyush Goyal**

### **Defence**

The indigenously developed air to surface missile (anti-tank version of HeliNa) successfully test-fired off Odisha coast is named – **SANT (Stand-off Anti-Tank)**

The eighth edition of annual bilateral maritime exercise to be held by the Navies of India and Sri Lanka off Trincomalee, Sri Lanka from 19 to 21.10.2020 is named – **SLINEX-20**

The second edition of Indian Navy (IN) – Bangladesh Navy (BN) Bilateral exercise to be held in Northern Bay of Bengal on 03 October 2020 is named – **Exercise Bongosagar**

The country which has test-fired Tsirkon hypersonic missile having a speed of Mach 8 (8 times the speed of sound) – **Russia**

The first indigenous anti-radiation missile developed by DRDO for Indian Air Force (IAF) and successfully flight tested (from Su-30MKI aircraft) onto a radiation target located on Wheeler Island off the coast of Odisha is named – **RUDRAM**

## Places

The Indian state which has become the first in the country to fix MSP (Minimum Support Price) for vegetables – **Kerala**

The European nation which has become the 190th member of the International Monetary Fund – **Andorra**

The state in which the first seedling of asafoetida was planted by CSIR-IHBT (asafoetida was not grown in India till now, but imported from Iran, Afghanistan and Uzbekistan) – **Himachal Pradesh**

The conservation site in Uttarakhand which has become the state's first Ramsar site, making it a Wetland of International Importance – **Asan Conservation Reserve**

The Indian state which has become the first Har Ghar Jal state in the country by providing tap water connection to every rural household – **Goa**

## Atal Tunnel

Inaugurated by: PM Shri Narendra Modi on 03 Oct 2020

### Features

1. Length of the tunnel is 9.02 kms
2. It is the longest highway tunnel in the world
3. It connects Manali to Lahaul-Spiti valley throughout the year. Earlier the valley was cut-off for 6 months due to snowfall.
4. It is built in the Pir Panjal mountains at a height of 3000 meters.
5. The tunnel reduces the road distance by 46 Kms between Manali and Leh and the time by about 4 to 5 hours.
6. It was earlier named Rohtang tunnel
